Researching a recipe.

Cooking a pasta dish. This dish may not be suitable for all tastes and the task is to research a dish like the one made in the lesson and explain why you have chosen to make this dish. This is known as a reason for choice.

A reason for choice is explaining (justifying) in your own words why you have chosen to make this dish.

Key words to use.

Explain, research, develop, record, make, plan, cook, serve, prepare, adapt, favourite, method, hygiene, ingredients, produce.

My top tip for this work is to write about a pasta meal that you have as a family. Students could right about recipes that have been handed down in the family.
