The website is [www.educake.co.uk](http://www.educake.co.uk) and each student has their own username and password to access questions that are specific to the course they are studying at school.

By using Educake, students are able to answer targeted homework questions from their teachers, as well as setting themselves questions on areas they wish to develop. This will help them to prepare for any end of unit assessments, GCSE exams or mock exams they may be doing in school.
